

Criteria for presentation grading

1 Items to be judged

1. Quality of slides

- Correct representation of the subject matter.
- Completeness with each slide and all the slides as the whole. The following slides should be present: Title slide; Presentation overview; Introduction slide(s); Conclusions and References.

2. Quality of oral presentation

- Keeping within the time slot
- Ability to engage the audience
- Correctness of exposition
- Familiarity of the subject
- Ability to address audience's questions

3. **Participation in the presentations of others by asking questions and/or expressing opinions**

- General and/or extensive questions are to be asked after a presentation.
- A “small” question, such as a typo or missed point, may be asked during a presentation.
